

Please return your completed B6T forms to the Front Office as soon as possible.
Returning the B6T transportation form is NOT a commitment to re-enroll for next year.

We must send the forms in good time to your local school district.

The district may deny transportation or reimbursement to families who submit late.

HOW TO FILL OUT YOUR TRANSPORTATION FORM

WHO: Any student age 5 or older by Oct. 1, 2012 who is a New Jersey resident

WHAT: Public school districts that provide transportation (busing) for their students are required to offer busing or transportation reimbursement to those students from their school districts who attend non-public schools. Submission of the enclosed B6T form is necessary in order to apply for transportation services or reimbursement in lieu of busing from your local school district **for the 2012-2013 school year**. Usually the local school districts opt to pay parents a set fee (currently over \$800 per child for the year) rather than provide busing to the Waldorf School of Princeton. This decision is made by each local school district.

WHEN: Fill out one B6T form per eligible child in your household and return to the Waldorf School of Princeton registrar by February 27, 2012 (returning students), or as soon as possible, (new students). **Each B6T form must be filled out COMPLETELY by you, and returned to the Waldorf School of Princeton** so that we can forward it to your school district. It is your responsibility to know what school district you reside in and to indicate it at the appropriate place on the B6T form. Please do not return the form directly to the district transportation office.

You will need to record the distance from your home to the school (WSP) measured in miles and tenths of miles (5.7 miles, for example). Do not list the distance to your local public school.

Returning students who submit the B6T form after March 1 may be denied reimbursement by their local school district. Please return the form NOW, even if you have not made a final decision about enrollment for next fall.

Students who are INELIGIBLE for New Jersey transportation services include:

- Children who do not meet the qualifying age for public school kindergarten.
- K-8 residing within two miles of school or more than 20 miles from school. If you wish, you may still submit the form; some districts allow students living within two miles of the school to receive the reimbursement.
- Pennsylvania or New York residents.

What happens next? After we submit your B6T, you will receive notification of approval/denial from the public school district. If approved for reimbursement, you will eventually receive additional forms (B7Ts) that must be filled out and returned *directly* to that district in order to receive your payment. This is usually in the fall of each year.

***IMPORTANT**

If you move after submitting this B6T, you will need to complete and submit a new form with your new address. The local school districts follow very strict rules and can refuse payment of the transportation money or pay at a decreased level if there are any inconsistencies or problems.
